PINE CENTER SPORTSMEN'S CLUB

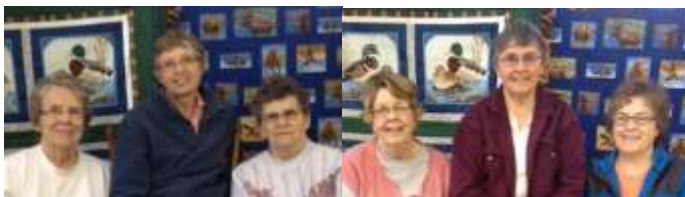
The Pine Center Sportsmen's Club Members have been busy hosting their fall events.
